

DRESS CODE

Members and visitors are expected to show respect for the Club environment, and for each other, by maintaining an acceptable standard of clean and tidy dress at all times both in the Clubhouse and on the golf course.

The general rule is that items of clothing sold as golf attire will be acceptable on the course. For men this will include the proviso that shirts are kept tucked in.

Spike Bar: The dress code in this area can be considered an extension of the golf course.

Lounge Area: Smart casual dress or clean, dry golfing attire may be worn. Golf shoes and waterproof clothing are not permitted.

Dining Room: Smart casual dress is appropriate at all times. Shorts are not permitted unless by prior agreement for an all-day golf event.

Denim: Please note that denim is not considered acceptable either on or off the course.

Members attention is drawn to the fact that dress for social, match and other events will be specified on event notices, and that for prize-giving presentations competitors are expected to change out of golf clothes.
