## Conditions of Entry

1. Entrants must be under the age of 18 years at 00.00 on 1<sup>st</sup> January in year of competition and hold an authorised handicap. \*CDH numbers (certification of exact handicaps) will be required (if applicable).

2. Entries will be limited to first 60 entries received.

NOTE: No entry fee will normally be refunded after the Starting Sheet has been posted. Any refund will be at the discretion of the Organising Committee.

## Conditions of Play

a) The Burford Junior Open main competition will be played over 18 holes stroke play.

b) The winner shall be the competitor (male or female) who returns the lowest gross score over 18 holes. In the event of a tie, a count-back will determine the winner.

c) Handicap prizes will be determined on count-back.

**Note**: Females will receive an additional number of strokes to their handicap to reflect the difference between the SSS of the men's (White Tee) and ladies' (Red Tee) courses.

d) All tied scores will be decided on the last 9, last 6, last 3 or last hole, in that order.

e) No competitor may win more than one main prize.

Additional Notes:

1. The 18 and 9 hole events are 'Qualifying competitions' for handicap purposes.
2. **No one over the age of 18 years may act as a caddie for any competitor in the 9 or 18 hole events**
3. The 6-hole stableford competition is for developing and academy players.
4. Rulings may only be obtained from delegated officials. If there is any doubt and a ruling is not immediately available, a competitor may proceed under Rule 3-3 of the Rules of Golf.
5. Any dispute will be settled by the Competition Committee of the day.
6. Local Rules other than on the Card will, if necessary, be available on the day.
7. If weather interferes with play the Organising Committee may vary the Conditions of Play (1a)

## DRESS CODE

**Male and Female competitors should wear approved golf clothing when on the Course and be smartly dressed for the Evening Presentation.**
